Welcome to Year One! We hope you had a very enjoyable summer break. Your child is now in Year 1 and will be taught by myself, Miss Prekouadio, along with our wonderful support team that consists of Mrs Buckingham, Miss Kallon and Mrs Iqbal

Throughout the year, we will be using themes to teach our theme based curriculum. Our running themes for the Autumn term are *Teddy Bear's Picnic* and *Toy Story*. Our themes will cover English, Geography, History, Music, PSHE, ICT, Art and DT and link to texts chosen to explore our themes for the term.

Children will need to wear Their P.E. kits on Tuesday for dance and Thursday for outdoor P.E. and will stay in there PE kit for the full day. Please ensure your child has appropriate kit for outdoor lessons, especially when the weather becomes colder. Shorts and T-shirts should always be worn for indoor P.E. **Please make sure your child's clothes are all labelled.** The children are responsible for all their own clothes, this includes their school uniform and jumpers and coats etc.

Spelling tests will be carried out on Mondays. The spellings will be given out by the end of each week. The children will be expected to write the spellings for the test independently.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom and books are changed every Friday. From next week children will take one book of their choice from the reading corner and a book which is targeted to their reading level that they should practice reading independently. We ask that you support your child's progress by reading regularly with them and completing the reading record when they have read to you. The book will only be changed when you have done so.
