In order to support your child's learning please use some time at home to research the topics we are studying and take an interest in what has been completed at school. We suggest that you listen to your child read at least **three times a week**, as this will vastly improve their reading and writing skills. Please remember to sign their reading record each time. **Your child cannot change their reading book until you have read with them and signed their reading record**.

Your child is expected to wear their PE uniform into school on Mondays and on Fridays. **Monday (outdoor)** and Friday (indoor) each week. For Indoor PE, the children must wear dark grey/blue or black shorts and a white t-shirt; for outdoor PE a tracksuit may be worn. Trainers or plimsolls must be worn.
