Wider curriculum objectives will be met, where possible, through the creative curriculum, linking these subjects to the theme of Medicine through Time. Maths objectives are met through the White Rose Maths Hub schemes of learning and Music follows the Charanga scheme of work.

Homework is set each week via teachers depending what each class requires. This may be in the form of example test papers or revision materials, online learning, reading at home and spelling (which is tested each **Friday**). Please ensure that your child is completing their homework regularly as it will greatly impact on their results.

Reading is a really important part of your child's learning. Children should read every evening for at least 20 minutes. We suggest that you listen to your child read at least three times a week, each time signing their reading journal – this will significantly improve their reading and writing skills ahead of SATs.

PE is on **Monday afternoon** (**outdoor**) **and Friday afternoon** (**indoor**) in **Walker** class and is on **Tuesday afternoon** (**outdoor**) **and Wednesday afternoon** (**indoor**) in **Einstein class.** Please ensure your child has appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons and all items are labelled. Earrings should not be worn on these days and no other jewelry should be worn to school.
