Spelling tests will continue to be carried out on Fridays, you will have received the spelling lists by now which are also available on the school website.

In order to support your child's learning please use some time at home to research the topics we are studying and take an interest in what has been completed at school. Your child will continue to bring home a reading record and reading book, which we expect them to read at home and bring into school every day. We suggest that you listen to your child read at least **three times a week**, as this will vastly improve their reading and writing skills. Please remember to sign their reading record each time. **Your child cannot change their reading book until you have read with them and signed their reading record**.

Your child is expected to come to school in their PE kit on Monday (indoor) and Wednesday (outdoor) for Fonteyn class and Wednesday (outdoor) and Thursday (indoor) for Cooper class. For Indoor PE, the children must wear dark grey or black shorts and a white t-shirt; for outdoor PE a tracksuit may be worn.
